PROTECTED ACTION BALLOT RESULT A LANDSLIDE

85% of members who voted in the February-March protected action ballot have voted in favour of strike action and bans on work outside the normal hours of prescribed duty.

This result sends a clear message to the NT Government that NT educators are determined to pursue their claims for improved salary and conditions, and that the Government's standing offer, which includes a 10% salary increase over three years and five mandatory school development days during stand-down, is far from satisfactory.

AEU-NT Executive will meet today via teleconference to determine an initial schedule for industrial action.

An update will be issued on Tuesday 25th March outlining the course of industrial action.
